

Gecko SA provides specialist Positive Behaviour Support delivered by experienced practitioners. We work with participants, families, and support teams to understand the reasons behind behaviours of concern and develop practical, evidence-based strategies that improve safety, wellbeing, and quality of life. Supports are trauma-informed, person-centred, and aligned with NDIS Quality and Safeguards requirements.

Skill-Building Group Programs

Gecko SA's Supported Independent Living (SIL) provides safe, small-scale shared home for people with complex support needs based in **Port Pirie**.

Our trauma-informed, relationship-based approach focuses on stability, skill development, and quality of life, with consistent staffing, clear routines, and strong safeguarding aligned to NDIS Quality and Safeguards requirements.

Supports may include assistance to access social, recreational, educational, and everyday activities, while building confidence, independence, and social skills.
